12000 Wilshire Blvd (attempt/commercial) 1

On 06/27/16, victim answered Craig's List ad for apartment for rent. Suspect told victim to wire money. Victim later checked location and there was no apartment for rent. A \$1,181.00 loss.

12000 Wilshire (commercial)

On 06/27/16, suspect entered store and removed property valued at \$130.00

300 Oceano

On 06/28/16, victim hired moving company to move items. They were not there when she arrived. A \$1,650.00 loss

11900 San Vicente (commercial)

On 06/28/16, suspect entered store and removed alcohol and electronics valued at \$1,033.00

11700 Mayfield

On 06/29/16, Unknown suspect(s) gained entry into an unsecured laundry room and stole property valued at \$2,100.00

1000 Lindenwood

On 06/29/16, Unknown suspect(s) approached victim's residence and stole packages from stoop valued at \$200.00

400 N. Saltair

Between 06/30/16 and 07/08/16, Unknown suspect(s) removed wood planks and tools valued at \$47,000.00

800 Wellesley

On 07/04/16, Unknown suspect(s) removed victim's wallet from purse while at a function.

11900 San Vicente Blvd (commercial)

On 07/09/16, Suspects removed items and left without paying for the products valued at \$456.00

1100 Wellesley

On 07/10/16, suspects remove victim's property as he was sleeping. Phone valued at \$1,300.00

11900 San Vicente Blvd (commercial)

On 07/11/16, victim hung her purse from the rear of her chair. Unknown suspect(s) removed wallet valued at \$1,000.00

11600 Mayfield

On 07/12/16, victim left phone to charge in laundry room. Unknown suspect(s) stole the phone valued at \$130.00

Note:

There were two reports recently of 'Craig's List' scams reported involving renting apartments and the wiring of money to strangers in order to secure them. Unfortunately, these victims found out that there was never an available apartment at all and the person who represented the 'manager' was acting fraudulently and now can't be found. Please be wary any time someone asks you to wire money, sight unseen. And keep in mind that police stations are open 24 hours and are a great place to meet to conduct Craig's List transactions and the like.

There was also another report of a purse hanging off the back of a chair in a restaurant/café and the purse/wallet was stolen without the victim's knowledge-until she went to pay for the check! Make it a habit to NEVER hang your purse or backpack off of the back of any chairs. There are roving thieves that will walk past, carrying a coat or sweater, and grab your property and walk out while it's hidden under the coat or sweater. Sometimes there's a distraction technique involved. They sell little hooks that you can hang your bags from the edge of the table in front of you. It's a worthy investment.

Lastly, although you report mail theft to the US Postal Inspector, if there's surveillance footage or images of the suspect or the act, please report it to the police as well. We are the ones that patrol the streets and can utilize the images. Tell your Post Office when you'll be out of town so they can hold your mail until you return. Consider having packages delivered to a friend or neighbor who is home during the day. Write specific instructions on where to leave it. Track your packages (some companies will send you an alert). Require a signature. Utilize companies that provide secure mailboxes. And insure it.
