ROBBERY: 1

Kiowa/Bundy

On 09/23/16 at 1645 hours, the victim was on foot and crossing the street at which time the suspect, in his vehicle, came to a sudden stop next to the victim. Startled, they engaged in a verbal dispute. Suspect then exited his vehicle and threw the victim to the ground. He then removed victim's wallet from his front pants pocket and fled in his vehicle. Suspect used racial slurs against the victim. Suspect described as a Male/White, blond short hair, 6'00", 300 lbs, in a tan vehicle.

On 09/01/16 between 1000 and 1300, unknown suspect(s) smashed victim's rear kitchen window and entered home and removed computers, watches and currency valued at \$29,500.00

On 09/14/16 between 1310 and 1335, unknown suspect(s) forced entry into residence via front door and removed jewelry valued at \$60,000.

On 09/16/16 between 1500 and 1800, unknown suspect(s) pried lock on French doors and removed jewelry valued at \$25,000.

12000 Wilshire (commercial/attempt)

Between 09/21/16 and 09/22/16, unknown suspect(s) used a pry tool to try and access café. They were unsuccessful

11900 San Vicente (commercial)

On 09/22/16 at 0445, witness arrived at location and saw the suspect (Male/Black, 6'00", 180 lbs) inside the location. The suspect fled out a smashed window. Unknown if any property was taken.

Between 09/16/16 and 09/18/16, unknown suspect(s) smashed vehicle window and removed a laptop computer and I-pad valued at \$1,650.00

Between 09/17/16 and 09/18/16, unknown suspect(s) entered subterranean garage and entered victim's vehicle and removed cleaning supplies valued at \$55.00

11900 Kiowa Ave

Between 09/18/16 and 09/19/16, unknown suspect(s) removed the license plate frames from the vehicle.

200 N. Cliffwood

Between 09/19/16 and 09/20/16, two suspects (Suspect 1: Male/White, Brown hair, age 25/30 and Suspect 2: Male/White, Blond Hair, age 25/30) parked their vehicle (light colored SUV) near the driveway of the victim's vehicle. They approached on foot and removed property from the victim's unlocked vehicle-golf travel bag and cash valued at \$3,980.00

11600 Montana

Between 09/19/16 and 09/20/16, two suspect(s) gained entry to garage and smashed vehicle window and stole sunglasses and paperwork valued at \$150.00 (suspects described as two Male/Whites, no further description)

11600 Montana

On 09/22/16, unknown suspect(s) smashed window and removed handbags and boots valued at 4285.00

GRAND THEFT & PETTY THEFT: 10

11700 Chenault St

Between 08/15/16 and 09/09/16, unknown suspect(s) removed vacuum, broom and mop from residence.

1000 S. Gretna Greene

Between 08/15/16 and 09/02/16, unknown suspect(s) removed victim's bike valued at \$9,200.00 from a storage shed.

100 Granville

Between 09/02/16 and 09/06/16, unknown suspect(s) entered unsecured construction site and removed \$3,000.00 in tools

800 Bringham

Between 09/05/16 and 09/06/16, unknown suspect(s) removed victim's wheels and tires from her vehicle leaving the vehicle on plastic crates -- a \$4,000.00 loss.

11700 Goshen

Between 08/04/16 and 09/06/16, unknown suspect(s) removed jewelry valued at \$10,950.00 from a drawer in victim's residence. Victim had multiple contractors working on his house at the time.

11300 Kiel St

On 09/07/16 at 2114, unknown suspect(s) entered unlocked front gate and took victim's bag of clothes valued at \$18,000.

2400 Pesquera (construction)

Between 09/07/16 and 09/08/16, unknown suspect(s) cut chain link fence and removed construction tools valued at \$8,900.00.

Barrington/Kiowa

On 09/08/16, between 0530 and 0545, victim was sitting at the bus bench and put his bag down on the ground. A few minutes later, when victim looked for the bag it was missing.

11600 San Vicente Blvd

On 09/10/16, between 1340 and 1400, unknown suspect(s) walked into an open store and removed cell phones from front counter.

1000 Hanley Ave

On 09/21/16, between 1045 and 1400, victim left cell phone unattended while working. When she returned to where she had left it, it was gone.

NOTE:

Although Brentwood is still down overall in burglaries for the year, we have experienced a recent uptick in residential, commercial, and construction site burglaries. As you can see from the above briefings, only one of the recent burglaries described has any suspect and/or vehicle descriptions to share. This is one area that I would like to see change significantly in the next few months. In light of the now very affordable, easily installed, security camera systems out there, there's no reason that our investigators have all these reportable burglaries with no suspect description.

I can't emphasize enough the need for home security camera systems, both inside your home and out, that provide instant notification to you, via your smartphone, with images of the suspect(s) that are inside your home (or trying to get inside your home). I will give you two examples of why this is so important...

First, if you only have a home security alarm system, and the alarm is activated by a possible intruder, it is a lower priority type of call in terms of police response. However, if you have a home security alarm system and it is activated by a possible intruder AND you are notified by your smartphone AND you can see and describe the suspects and what they are doing, then the priority goes up to the top as a crime in

progress at which time the police, often times the helicopter, all respond in force making it much more likely that they'll be apprehended.

Secondly, if you live in the Mandeville/Westridge Canyon areas, and you have experienced a crime at your home, you want the date/time stamp that the crime occurred and the description of the suspects, particularly their vehicle, so that it will correlate with an observable window of time for detectives to study the cameras that are situated at the base of Mandeville Canyon. Without specifically something to look for, the cameras are of little help to investigating detectives. The Ring doorbell is one example of the outdoor camera systems that often catch video, not only of the suspects that came onto your property, but also the car that they drove up in.

Please consider upgrading your home security so that detectives will have something to work with.
