ASSAULT OR ADW (Assault with a Deadly Weapon): 1

11600 San Vicente

On 07/22/16, at 0830, following a road rage incident, the suspect followed the victim into a parking garage and intentionally struck his vehicle with her vehicle and then fled. Suspect described as Female, Hispanic, dark hair, in a green Honda Accord.

BURGLARY: 6

500 Tigertail

Between 07/17/16 and 07/24/16, unknown suspect(s) kicked open residential side door and removed collectables and camera valued at \$1,000.00

600 Barrington

On 07/20/16, at 0025, suspect entered apartment complex through front door. The suspect used a key to open mailboxes and steal mail. Suspect described as a Male, age 40/50. Unknown what the property loss was.

On 07/23/16 at 2100, unknown suspect(s) broke a window out of a rear door and exited out the front door. Unknown if there was any property loss.

Goshen/San Vicente

Between 08/04/16 and 08/05/16, unknown suspect(s) reached into open window and unlocked vehicle and took currency and gift cards valued at \$335.00

400 Bowling Green Way

Between 08/04/16 and 08/05/16, unknown suspect(s) unlocked vehicle and removed a purse and sunglasses with a total value of \$500.00

GRAND THEFT & PETTY THEFT: 4

11900 San Vicente Blvd

On 07/20/16, between 1400 and 1530, unknown suspect removed victim's purse that she had hung on the back of her chair while she dined.

Bundy/Wilshire

On 07/22/16, between 1500 and 1502, unknown suspect stole victim's keys that were placed on the counter of the store.

900 Bundy

On 07/28/16, between 0730 and 2230, unknown suspect walked into victim's garage and stole a bicycle valued at \$600.00

200 26th Street

On 07/31/16 at 1230, suspect entered store and removed a bracelet valued at \$300.00. Suspect described as a Male, White, grey hair, 45/50 years old.

Note:

While I can't mention all of them, I want to take a moment to share another outstanding arrest made by our West LA officers. On July 21, 2016, at 2:00 am, two women were arrested after they were observed walking in and out of various apartment/condo complexes in the Bundy/Goshen/Westgate/Granville/Gorham vicinity. They had in their possession a general use mailbox key which not only afforded them the ability to enter the lobbies of numerous complexes, but also allowed them to access the mailboxes within the lobbies. They were simply walking from building to building and stealing what they could get their hands on. Both were arrested for burglary.

I've mentioned before how these keys sometimes end up in the hands of thieves... Seasonal postal workers, fired or disgruntled postal workers, etc., allow for the keys to be copied, stolen and/or sold. The problem is rampant. Please take measures to pick up your mail at the earliest opportunity. If mail/package theft is suspected, please have someone review the security tapes and provide copies to police.

Lastly, we are still experiencing a downward trend in overall crime for the Brentwood area. We are down 34.4% in burglaries, 3.2% down in vehicle break-ins, and we are breaking even in grand theft auto at 0%. So while I want to enjoy this reprieve (that I hopefully didn't just jinx) I still want

folks to maintain vigilance about keeping their homes secured and ALL items out of their cars, always.
